



Exhibition Display Agreement Terms and Conditions

Bonsai Society of Queensland Inc.

After reading these terms and conditions, you should sign the Exhibition Display Agreement sheet, which lists the bonsai, stands etc. that you have submitted for display at the annual exhibition ('the exhibition') wherever, whenever and for however long it runs.

1. I acknowledge that the Bonsai Society of Queensland Inc., including the management committee (BSQ Inc.) undertakes to take due care and attention in handling and displaying the bonsai, stone(s) and/or other display items that I submit for display at the exhibition ('my bonsai' and 'my items').
2. The exhibition is open to the public, BSQ Inc. and I acknowledge that there are risks involved.
3. In respect of my bonsai, I have complied with all relevant statutory requirements in respect of the movement of plants from location to location and the cultivation of plants.
4. I have examined each of my bonsai and it/they do not contain insect pests and/or disease or it/they have been appropriately treated for possible insect pest and/or disease.
5. I will not hold BSQ Inc. at fault or liable for any pest or disease infestation that may occur to my bonsai at the exhibition.
6. I acknowledge that BSQ Inc. has the right to remove any of my bonsai or my items from the exhibition for any reason without notice.
7. I give permission to BSQ Inc. to use images of my bonsai and/or my items in promotional materials for BSQ Inc.

Some of the statutory requirements include the: *Plant Protection Act 1989* to prevent, control or remove pest infestation of plants in Queensland, *Land Protection (Pest Stock Route Management) Act 2002* about the management of particular pests on land and other matters and various Brisbane City Council by-laws.
