

Exhibition Sales Agreement Terms and Conditions

Bonsai Society of Queensland Inc.

After reading these terms and conditions, **you should initial the Exhibition Sales Agreement and Sheet**, which lists the bonsai, plants and bonsai related items you have for sale ('my items' or 'the items') through the Bonsai Society of Queensland Inc. (BSQ Inc.) at the annual exhibition ('the exhibition').

BSQ Inc.:

- 1. undertakes to take due care and attention in handling, selling and accounting for, paying you for sales in respect of the items
- 2. will sell the items during the opening hours of the exhibition, not otherwise
- 3. reserves the right to remove any of the items from sale during the exhibition
- 4. will undertake to pay you for sales of the items after closing time for the exhibition or soon after by any method available to BSQ Inc.
- 5. is not registered for the Goods and Services Tax'

I (the seller):

- 6. declare that all my items are my property and are not subject to any restrictions under the law
- 7. agree to BSQ Inc. selling the items on my behalf at the exhibition
- 8. agree to pay BSQ Inc. a fee of 10 per cent on the sale of each of my items, if I display one or more bonsai or stone(s) at the exhibition, otherwise 20 per cent
- 9. agree to the fee being paid by BSQ Inc. by deducting the amount from the total of sales of my items
- 10. have complied with all legal requirements in respect of the movement of plants, plant diseases and pests in respect of my items
- 11. agree that if I alter the price marked on any of my items sold during the exhibition, I will advise BSQ Inc. in sufficient time for BSQ Inc. to properly account for the sale(s)
- 12. indemnify BSQ Inc. for any loss, damage or injury due to my breach of the law or actions at or in respect of the exhibition.

Some of the statutory requirements include the: *Plant Protection Act 1989* to prevent, control or remove pest infestation of plants in Queensland. *Land Protection (Pest Stock Route Management) Act 2002* about the management of particular pests on land and other matters and various Brisbane City Council by-laws.
